NOTE:

- If the proposed project requires more than one (1) acre of disturbance or is located within 200 feet of State Waters, this form and accompanying display card shall serve as an official **Land Disturbing Activity Permit (LDAP)**. Prior to the issuance of an LDAP, a Notice of Intent (NOI) and associated fee of \$40 per disturbed acre must be submitted to the State. Erosion control plans must also be approved by the Georgia Soil & Water Conservation Commission (GSWCC).
- If the proposed project disturbs less than an acre and is more than 200 feet from State Waters, the form and accompanying display card shall serve as a **Grading Permit**. Review of erosion control plans will be conducted by the City of Statesboro Engineering Department. A flat \$40 fee will be collected for Grading Permits.
- The City of Statesboro determines if the project is within 200 feet of State Waters.
