

**RESOLUTION 2026-01:
A RESOLUTION APPROVING APPLICATION TO THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION GRANT PROGRAM FOR
HYDROLOGIC AND HYDRAULIC STUDY OF LITTLE LOTTS CREEK BASIN**

THAT WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council desire to maintain a well regulated watershed that provides for effective and efficient management of stormwater and provides protection of life, property, and Statesboro’s environment and natural resources; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have found that effective stormwater management of Little Lotts Creek will improve water quality and maintain a healthy environment for its citizens and the community beyond the Statesboro city limits; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council have found that the Federal Emergency Management Agency’s Hazard Mitigation Grant Program is desirable in order to provide financial support for further study and enhancement of Little Lotts Creek and Bird’s Pond; and,

WHEREAS, city staff will prepare application to said program in order to obtain a maximum grant award of up to \$945,000; and,

WHEREAS, a 10% local match (\$94,500) required which will be provided by Stormwater Fund revenues.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of Statesboro, Georgia as follows:


- Section 1. The Mayor and City Council hereby authorize the submittal of application to FEMA for aforementioned grant program.
