

RESOLUTION 2026 - 03: A RESOLUTION APPROVING AWARD OF CONTRACT FOR PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE 2026 COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT

THAT WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs has announced the availability of 2026 Community Development Block Grant competitive grant funds which may be utilized for the improvement of public infrastructure; and,

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council of Statesboro, have determined infrastructure improvements to Roundtree Street and Church Street, from College Street to Martin Luther King, Jr. Boulevard, are meritorious of application of a Community Development Block Grant; and,

WHEREAS, City staff have properly advertised a request for qualifications for professional engineering services for the application of the 2026 Community Development Block Grant in accordance with regulations set forth by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs; and,

WHEREAS, a selection committee comprised of qualified City staff having reviewed the submittals received has provided an informed recommendation of award in regard to the evaluation criteria set forth in the advertisement and request for qualifications documents; and,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and City Council of Statesboro, Georgia as follows:

Section 1. That the City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with Parker Engineering, LLC for professional engineering services for the 2026 Community Development Block Grant.

Section 2. That funding is conditioned upon grant approval and receipt of 2026 Community Development Block Grant funding, and matching funds of 10% to be provided by 2025 SPLOST funds.

Section 3. That the fees for professional engineering services for the 2026 Community Development Block Grant are limited to the maximum amount established in the rules and regulations of the grant award as set forth by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs and shall be paid from grant funds awarded, and required matching funds of 10% from 2025 SPLOST funds.

Section 4. This Resolution shall be and remain in full force and effect from and after its date of adoption.
