Re: Recommendation: Architectural Services/Fire Department

The City of Statesboro issued a request for qualifications (RFQ) for architectural services to design a remodel of station one on West Grady and a new design for an additional fire station(s) in the future. Our evaluation process involved two stages. Firms were asked to submit a response to our RFQ. At that point, each member of the evaluation committee performed an evaluation based on the listed criteria in the RFQ (100 point scale). For the second stage, the top three firms were asked to perform presentations to explain, in detail, their qualifications and approach to our project(s). After these presentations, each evaluation member numerically graded these presentations based on each firm's presentation and answers to several standard questions (80 point scale). After these presentations, the committee met once more to compare scores and to discuss the ratings of the firms. At this meeting, Martin Rule & Associates/Stewart Cooper Newell was chosen as they, in the opinion of the committee, offered the best resources for our projects. The firms who responded to our RFQ are listed below with the ones invited to perform presentations in bold print:

- 1. Martin Rule & Assoc./ Stewart Cooper Newell
- 2. Palmer Architects/Parker Engineering
- 3. HGBD Architects & Engineering
- 4. JLA Architects
- 5. McCall & Associates, Inc.
- 6. Pope & Partners, Inc.

All presentations were of high caliber, but the evaluation committee unanimously selected Martin Rule & Associates/Stewart Cooper Newell. In the final analysis, this firm consistently scored the highest and it was felt, by the committee, they were the best solution to our design needs. Martin Rule & Associates brings local knowledge and experience and Stewart Cooper Newell has been involved in over 250 fire station design

projects. It is our recommendation that the architectural services contract be awarded to Martin Rule & Associates/Stewart Cooper Newell. If approved, negotiations will begin until an agreement is reached. If, for some reason an agreement can't be reached, we will return to Council for approval of our second choice for these services. The amount paid for these services will be covered in the, already approved, capital budget for fire station construction. After an architectural design is accepted, the construction phase shall be bid out per our ordinance requirements.
