



**CITY OF STATESBORO
Council Minutes
February 04, 2014**

A regular meeting of the Statesboro City Council was held on February 4th, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Present were Mayor Jan J. Moore, Council Members: Will Britt, Phil Boyum, Gary Lewis and Travis Chance. Also present were City Manager Frank Parker, Assistant City Clerk Heather Anderson, City Attorney Alvin Leaphart, City Engineer Robert Cheshire and Director of Community Development Mandi Cody. Councilman John Riggs and City Clerk Sue Starling were absent.
