A work session of the Statesboro City Council was held on April 03, 2012 at 9:45 a.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Topics for Discussion

Solid Waste Disposal (new compactor purchase)

Senior City Engineer Jason Boyles updated Council on the potential purchase of a new compactor for the landfill stating it will extend the life of the landfill for about 15 years.

Solid Waste Collection (updates, ordinance amendments, and fee proposals).

Senior City Engineer Jason Boyles and Sanitation Superintendent Mike Clifton updated Council on Ordinance amendments, fee proposals and other ways to improve trash pickup procedures.

Discussion of elevated storage tank logo (colors)

Director of Water Wastewater Wayne Johnson updated Council on the water tank logo. He presented them with choices of colors and wording for the tank

Discussion of extension of sewer under Cawana Road at railroad bed

Director of Water Wastewater Wayne Johnson updated Council on the importance of the extension of the sewer under the railroad bed at Cawana Road.
