Salvage Drainage Pipe Surplus and Disposal Request

The Street Division has numerous salvage drainage pipes in storage on the yard at Public Works. These pipes are either damaged or cracked and are not useable for structural loading (particularly within a public right of way). From discussions with staff, my understanding is that prior to me assuming administrative responsibility of our Public Works divisions salvage pipe was offered free of charge to anyone requesting it as a means of reducing our tippage fees and disposal burdens. In the last year I have received several requests for this salvage material but have refrained from allowing this to be acquired until I could formally present this to City Council. I am now prepared to present this item to City Council requesting that salvage pipe be approved for surplus and disposal as acquired. Following approval by City Council I will place an ad in the Statesboro Herald stating that the city has salvage pipe available on a first come, first served basis and any interested parties can contact Public Works for more information. We will then have each interested party sign a release/liability waiver upon securing any salvage pipe.
