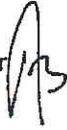

Re: Recommendation of Bid Award for New Automated Side Loader Truck

On March 17, 2011 the city received eight sealed bids for the purchase of a new automated side loader. I have reviewed all bids received and the lowest bid that meets (or exceeds) all minimum specifications is for a 2012 Peterbilt cab & chassis with a 2012 New Way automated side loader refuse body submitted by Peterbilt Truck Centers (of Savannah) in the amount of \$229,537.00. This equipment will be purchased with a combination of SPLOST funds and solid waste collection funds. Further, funding for purchase of this truck has been appropriated for FY2011 and the aforementioned bid is under the \$250,000 budget amount.

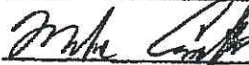

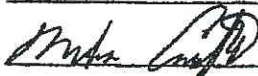

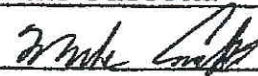

Following approval by City Council I will place an ad in the Statesboro Herald stating that the city has salvage pipe available on a first come, first served basis and any interested parties can contact Public Works for more information. We will then have each interested party sign a release/liability waiver upon securing any salvage pipe.
