Recommendation: Emergency Generator Installation Bid Award

The City of Statesboro recently solicited sealed bids for an emergency generator for use by our Public Works Department. This generator will be used in cases of power outages in order to keep operations online. An 85kw Cummins Genset natural gas generator was specified and this bid package was turn-key in nature. Our current peak usage over the last year is approximately 42kw per information provided by Georgia Power thus, this generator will allow for considerable growth for future applications. The contractor is to provide the generator, electrical connection, concrete pad and all materials and labor required for complete installation. The budget for this project was \$50,000 and this project, if approved, will be funded out of the Fleet Management Fund. An invitation to bid was sent to seven (7) electrical contractors. We had three contractors attend the mandatory pre-bid meeting and the sealed bid submittal results are as follows:

1. HEMCO Inc.

\$47,380.00

2. Y-Delta Inc.

\$53,944.00

Having met all the required specifications and having offered the lowest responsive bid, we recommend the bid award be made to HEMCO Inc. per their submitted bid of \$47,380.00. HEMCO has performed favorable previous electrical work at Public Works and has extensive experience in this type of installation.


