**THAT WHEREAS**, the Georgia Department of Community Affairs has announced the availability of FY2019 Community Development Block Grant competitive grant funds which may be utilized for the improvement of public infrastructure; and,

**WHEREAS**, the City of Statesboro, having properly advertised a request for qualifications for professional engineering services for the application of the FY2019 Community Development Block Grant in accordance with regulations set forth by the Georgia Department of Community Affairs; and,

**WHEREAS**, a selection committee comprised of qualified City staff having reviewed the submittals received has provided an informed recommendation of award in regard to the evaluation criteria set forth in the advertisement and request for qualifications documents; and,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and City Council of Statesboro, Georgia as follows:
