The Department of Planning and Development has reviewed the alcoholic beverage application submitted by Cracker Barrel for 216 Henry Boulevard. The applicant is proposing retail package sales of malt beverages and wine for a "restaurant" at the location. The proposed sale of alcoholic beverages is permitted at the location and **the application may be APPROVED**. Staff's recommendation is based on the following:

- 1) Zoning District: 216 Henry Boulevard is located in the CR (Commercial Retail) district.
- 2) Zoning Use Classification: Per Article X, by reference to Article VIII, a "restaurant" may be classified in the CR (Commercial Retail) district as:
 - Retail or wholesale establishments
- 3) Alcohol Beverages Proximity Restrictions: The Department of Planning & Development has reviewed the subject property for consistency with the proximity restrictions of Chapter 6, Section 6-7 (d) of *Statesboro Codes and Ordinances*. The proposed location is required to adhere to the regulations set forth by O.C.G.A. § 3-3-21. As per Chapter 6-7, Class B and C licenses shall be issued for a location only if the location complies with the proximity requirements provided by O.C.G.A. § 3-3-21 as measured by the rules and regulations promulgated by the Georgia Department of Revenue. The proposed location is required to adhere to the proximity requirements and package sales for off-premises consumption governed by O.C.G.A. § 3-3-21.

The Department of Planning and Development recommendation of **approval** is based on the information provided within the business occupational tax application submitted for our review. This approval does not confer rights to open or operate the proposed business until all dimensional requirements of the *Statesboro Zoning Ordinance*, or applicable requirements of any other chapter of City Code have been met.

Background:

We are in the third year of a three year contract with our insurance broker Glenn Davis. They are charged with shopping our insurance policies to the carriers to obtain the highest quality service at the best price possible. Travelers (our current carrier) is recommended above to provide our property and casualty general liability insurance and Bitco (our current carrier) is recommended to provide our workers compensation insurance. VFIS has been recommended to provide property and equipment insurance for our Fire Department. VFIS is a specialty insurance provider for fire departments. VFIS replaces damaged facilities and equipment at current day prices and provides numerous training opportunities throughout the year that are currently utilized. This expense is separate and is broken out of the P&C General liability coverage for the rest of the City of Statesboro departments. GMA was consulted and offered a quote of \$759,610.55 for P&C General Liability insurance coverage and declined to bid on our workers compensation insurance due to an increase in recent claims. Bitco was added to their P&C General Liability insurance quote to produce a comparative total of \$1,136,999.55. There would also be a tail coverage when if switching to GMA to cover any previous claims due to the pool-type coverage GMA offers. This additional amount would total approximately \$40,000.00. These totals are subject to change throughout the year with the addition of vehicles, facilities and any staff members.


