A regular meeting of the Statesboro City Council was held on September 4th 2018 at 9:00p.m. in the Council Chambers at City Hall. Present were Mayor Jonathan McCollar, Council Members: Phil Boyum, Sam Lee Jones, Jeff Yawn, John Riggs and Derek Duke. Also present were City Manager Randy Wetmore, City Clerk Sue Starling and City Attorney Cain Smith.
